
NATIVE TITLE & ABORIGINAL HERITAGE POLICY

BREAKAWAY EARTHMOVING recognises that under common law and Acts of Parliament different groups of aboriginals have claim or rights to a large amount of land in Australia.

BREAKAWAY EARTHMOVING respects areas of significance to aboriginal culture and tradition of certain locations in Australia.

BREAKAWAY EARTHMOVING policy on native title & aboriginal heritage is as follows:

1. To determine, where possible, aboriginal areas of significance or sacred sites on land being accessed and to avoid these areas.
2. While working on aboriginal reserves or claimed lands to respect the wishes of aboriginal communities with their local rules, such as, no admission of alcohol or petrol on site.
3. Train employees in basic statutory requirements with regards to entry and working on aboriginal lands.
4. To promote employee understanding of and cooperation with the aboriginal people.
5. To cooperate with the Client in the negotiation process of Native Title where possible
