The objectives of this policy are to:

- prevent workplace accidents and disease;
- protect employees from safety and health hazards which may arise out of their work by providing safe workplaces, plant and systems of work;
- Establish and maintain best practice programs to meet the policy.

Management at all levels is responsible for developing, implementing and maintaining the occupational health and safety system to eliminate hazards and control the risks within the work environment.


Employees have a responsibility to ensure their own safety and health, and the safety and health of others, and to comply with instructions given.

- provide training, information, instruction and supervision for all employees to enable them to perform their duties safely;
- identify hazards, assess the risks and implement measures to control the risks;
